On the day the Mayor shut down 7th Street NW in an annual program misnamed 'Open Streets,' residents complain the proposed plans are dangerous and remove more than 100 parking spaces in a densely populated residential/commercial neighborhood, adjacent to the U Street corridor.

Residents complain their voices have been ignored by DDOT and by their ANC. ANC!B has scheduled a vote on the plan **Thursday, September 10 at 6:30 pm by Zoom**. Residents are asking for a pause in the planning and appealing to Mayor Bowser and DC Councilmembers.
